Located in the heart of the city, one of the most famous and most elegant Paris hotels is most certainly the well known Hotel Ritz where many famous people have stayed including Princess Diana and Hemingway.

The hotel was build in 1898 and the interior of this Paris hotel is filled with Louis XVI furniture. Be sure to try out some of the food and beverage outlets at the Hotel Ritz Paris as they have some of the best chefs in France.

Hotel Ritz Paris building's façade was designed by Jules Hardouin Mansart, the creator of the "mansard" roof. Converted to a luxury hotel by César Ritz, it opened on June 1, 1898. Together with the culinary talents of minority partner Auguste Escoffier, César Ritz made the hotel synonymous with opulence, service, and fine dining.
