One of the most exclusive Paris shopping venues is the Rue des Francs-Bourgeois, which is a small road filled with a number of exclusive shops and stores including Ventilo and Campers.

Please try to visit the Paris shopping venue on a Sunday as the atmosphere is really great on that day of the week. Francs-Bourgeois's street is one of the longer and the most interesting of le Marais. Starting from Beaubourg (rue Rambuteau), it is today a trendy street that is much appreciated for all the fashion stores.

The street is opened on Sunday so many people come to brunch and walk there at the end of the week.

The Rue des Francs-Bourgeois is impossible to miss if you visit le Marais.

In the past the street was called rue des Poulies. But in 1415 a so-called le Mazurier offered to the grand Prieur of France a huge private mansion with 24 bedrooms to receive 48 poor people. These people were so poor they didn't pay the taxes of the city and were called francs-bourgeois, which is the origin of the street's name.
